Problem

My use to CAE as a teacher of clients a teacher awakener an instigator of writigg etc...

depends on : - being alive (not in lousy depression)

- on being outside CAE as well as in it
- on continuation of high public profile as writer and teacher trainer

Current subjective reality (MR)

I belong intensely to CAE- I am firmly committed to Japanese learning with JW- rapport with him is very firm and warm. I am firmly committed to the "three book Graces". This has been a fantastic project- massive self training and team building: just in hours it astounds me: 2 hours a week girtually unbroken over 15 months plus 3-4 full days at Xmas, 91. The work has infuenced our class room teaching, our knowledge of and feeli: g for each other and our knowledge of each other as professionals. I have collaborated reasonably with JB and Julie over particular classes.

I belong intensely to the mad, gypsy circus called Pilgims. I have lived much of what happened on the Canterbury hilltop this summer vicariously over the phone. I am directly involved with publications. You don't abandon a massively useful and successful peer group without a real need to do so, which I donet have.

A possible solution

I work September 20th to March 30th for CAE in role as language teacher and idea stirrer in the staff room. (I now have sufficient rapport with each person to do that - you can only train and lead in a group within the frame of such rapport, I feel- to omo imas.)

From April Fools Day till Sept 19th I work for Piggrims (April thru June: one month on the road + two at home writing July-August; reacher training in Canterbury - Sept writing + on the read for perhaps a week.

Benefits to CAE: I act as a conductor wire for fresh ideas- I feel I can now really let these loose- so far it has been fairly necessary to pussy-foot.

I stay public and so useful as a publicity device- maybe ways of using this more should be sought.

I teach over six months at full steam-using these groups as real laboratories, as I have done this summer. I light the satisfaction.

Benefits to Pilgrims - my energy is also at their disposal but a healthy remove is maintained.

Benefits to S and B

Spouse + father firmly in Cambridge for half the year. One months travelling but corralled into a three month period. The traditional 2 months villegiature in Canterbury that S this summer said she missed Benefits to me

- Cambridge centred
- full group support agst depression for 8 months a year
- proper lengthed language classes to work with (eg Tokai one year, ll week courses- nothing in Canterbury lasts more than four weeks-teachers there can only do the 100 metres and the 440.)
- a judicious amount of open time to write in and at a sensible time of year.
- sensible, balanced continuation of career.

I would propose that, if some of the above makes sense to you, we should enter into an agreement for three years, and so avoid my flea-like behaviour of the last two years.

I suspect that Arman and J could well hatch projects of mutual benefit from an arrangement of this sort. (some cross marketing- airing of CAE teachers at Pilgrims - TT openings in Canterbury etc..)

I am aware of the current need to shed teachers at CAE- I also note that you like to try to take a mid-term rather than an immediate term view.
